# Delta First 5 Center In Person and Virtual Programming Class and Event Descriptions September/October 2023

# **Baby Signs- Tuesdays**

(In Person) 1 yr olds

An interactive play group that will help parents and children learn useful signs, songs, and games. Through singing, dancing, and activities that highlight important developmental skills, parents and kids will begin signing right away.

# **Bridge to Kindergarten-Wednesdays**

(In Person) 4-5 yr olds

Children and parents will begin to learn the skills that will be necessary to be ready for school. Activities will directly coincide with the California standards for kindergarten.

# **Bright & Beyond- Thursday**

(In Person) 1-2 yrs old

This class will demonstrate how to use the Bright & Beyond activity cards at home with your child. Bright & Beyond activity cards encourage children's development with easy, enjoyable parent and child activities. The cards provide intriguing, age specific activities that promote thinking, coordination, creativity, and more by using simple, everyday items that families already have at home.

# **Delta Literacy Partners- Mondays**

# Let's Count & Match with Ms. Bernice- Saturday

# (In Person) 3 yr olds

Parents and caretakers will explore and engage with their children in a fundamental way of learning and matching numbers and colors. Through this class children will enhance their memory skills through using everyday materials.

# **Nurturing Parents- Tuesdays**

# (In Person) Adults

This is a 18 weeks group based program. Parents learn about recognizing and understanding feelings, infant and child massage, nurturing parenting routines, alternatives to hitting, child development and ways to build self-esteem and self concept.

# **Potty Training Workshop-Fridays**

# (Virtual) Adults

Come learn about this transitional time in families' lives. Ideas and tips will be shared about how to navigate the growth of going from diapers to independently bathroom use.

# Ready for Learning- Mondays & Thursdays

# (In Person) 3 yr olds

Children will be introduced to concepts of colors, shapes and letters. They will build on skills such as writing, cutting and working with others.

# **Ready for Learning at Vintage- Mondays**

# (In Person) 3-5 yr olds

This program takes place at Vintage Parkway Elementary School. Children will be introduced to concepts of colors, shapes and letters. They will build on skills such as writing, cutting and working with others.

# **Road Map to Kindergarten-Wednesdays**
